Covid-19 maskīkiy kaki-otinēn kīspin ki-tēpakēnimon. aniki nīkan inisīniwak nawac mistahi ka-otawēnītākik ka-mīnīwak (*COVID-19 vaccines are voluntary. Highest risks groups are being offered vaccines according to priority*).

### nīkan (Phase 1):

- iyisīniwak ka-wīkīcik wāskahikanihk itē ka-pamihīcik (mōna takīkac ka-kētēyīcik) (*Long term care and personal care home residents (no age restriction)*)
- kētēyak ka-itahtopiponēcik tēpakohpomitanaw (mīna nēhinawak)(*Residents 70 years and older (includes Indigenous populations)*)
- nēhiyawak ka-itahtopiponēcik nēwo-mitanaw mīna kayātē (*First Nations residents 40 years and older*)
- nēhiyawak ka-itohtapiponēcik niyānāno-mitanaw ka-wīkīcik kiwētīnohk iskonikana (*All residents 50 years and older living in northern and remote communities*)
- maskīkinīniwak kā-pamihācik mēkwaci nisīniwa pīsīk kā-āhkōsīk (*Health care workers that are caring for patients with COVID-19 on a very regular basis*).
