

Close Contact:

- family members and caregivers or who had other similar close physical contact (e.g. intimate partner) without consistent and appropriate use of recommended PPE;

OR

- lived with or had otherwise close prolonged contact (within 2 metres) with a probable or confirmed case while the case was symptomatic and not self-isolating;
 OR
- had direct contact with infectious body fluids of a case (e.g., was coughed or sneezed on or shared personal items such as eating utensils or drinking cups) without the appropriate use of recommended personal protective equipment.

Non-Close Contact:

- Provided care for the case, (including health care workers, family members or other caregivers) or who had other similar close physical contact with consistent and appropriate use of personal protective equipment and the case was self-isolating OR
- who lived with or had prolonged contact but **was not within 2 metres** of a case while the case was symptomatic and not self-isolating

Not a Contact:

- Only transient interactions (e.g. walking by the case or being briefly in the same room)
